College Admission Procedures

Requirements for college admission vary from school to school so it is vital to know specific requirements for the college a student wants to apply to. Meeting entrance requirements does not mean a student will get selected. It means a student may hit the “submit” button on the application. In order to be selected for admission, students will have to compete with many other students qualified for admission who may have a higher GPA, are more involved in outside activities, have higher test scores and/or wrote a better essay. It is important to understand that just because a student meets the minimum qualifications for admission it in no way means they will be selected for admission. Students must do their very best academically and determine how to be the best candidate for admission for their school of choice.

REMEMBER when requesting your transcripts and any other information from the Counseling Office that you need to include a stamped addressed envelope so we know where to send things. Also, allow enough time so you don't miss important deadlines!

California State University (CSU)

Application Window: Oct. 1st –Nov. 30th

CSU Application opens October 1st - Apply Early!

Important CSU Information:

Many campuses are impacted so it is best to take the SAT/ACT by **NOVEMBER!**

DECEMBER is the last test date accepted in order for your application to be considered.

Refer to the SAT/ACT link for information on submitting your scores

Have Plan B, C, and D... in case you do not get admitted to your 1st choice campus

CSU East Bay and CSU Monterey Bay are two campuses that will be accepting all eligible applicants

Be sure to check your email accounts for important information once you submit your applications regarding signing up for campus portal sites

Monitor your application via the campus portal sites

Respond quickly to any request for additional information

University of California (UC)

Application Window: November 1st – 30th

The application is available beginning October 1st

Mrs. Schaffran or Ms. Moore should review your application before you submit

Important UC Information:

Must take SAT/ACT and/or SAT Subject Tests by DECEMBER

NEW: Must make sure to SEND all your SAT Reasoning and Subject Test scores to at least one UC campus. All other campuses you apply to will then have access to your scores.

ACT Scores need to be sent separately to each UC campus you apply to.

Make sure you accurately reflect your transcript on your application

Be sure to check your email accounts for important information once you submit your applications regarding signing up for campus portal sites

Monitor your application via the campus portal sites

Respond quickly to any request for additional information

Private Universities:

Check each individual school. Many private universities use the Common Application which is very helpful when applying to more than one college.
